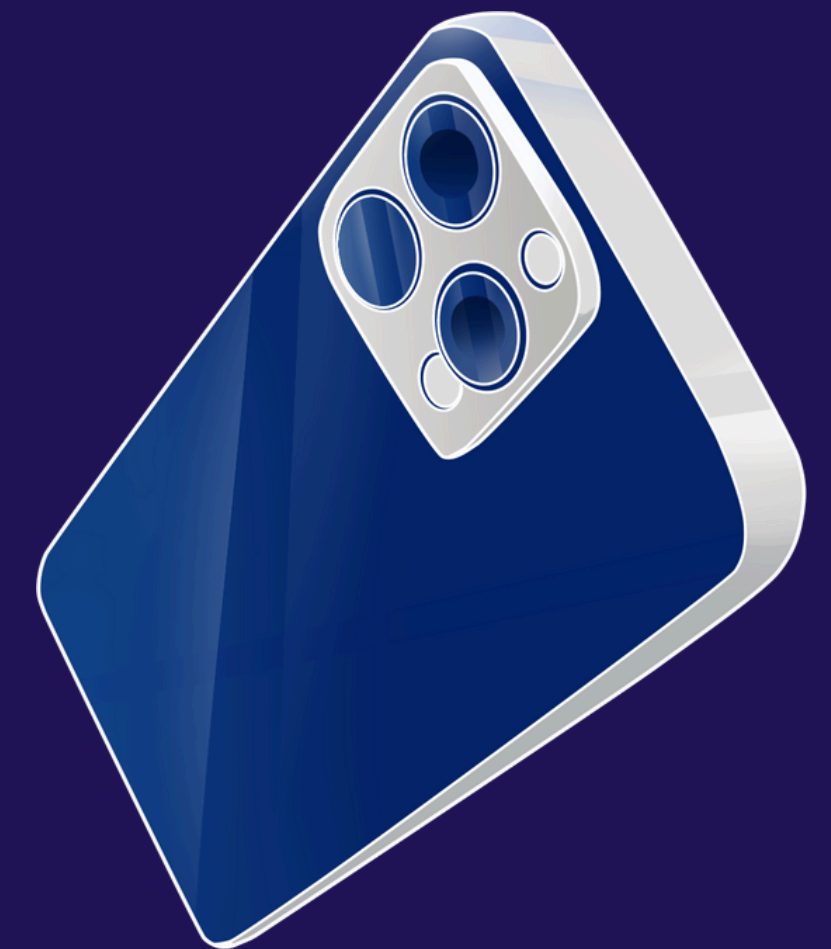

Apple Shrinks iPhones While Alphabet Expands to \$3 Trillion

Alphabet's surge past \$3 trillion wasn't luck. A favorable antitrust ruling gave investors confidence, cementing Google's parent as one of the most valuable companies in history. It signals not just market dominance but also regulatory resilience, a combination few rivals can claim. Apple, meanwhile, unveiled its boldest lineup in years. It launched the thinnest iPhone ever, health-tracking AirPods, and smarter Apple Watches. This tightens its grip on the consumer ecosystem.

The momentum doesn't stop there. Microsoft is hedging bets with Anthropic to strengthen Office 365, while OpenAI's \$300 billion Oracle deal sets the stage for a new era of AI infrastructure. Add to that Albania's appointment of the world's first AI minister, NVIDIA's Rubin CPX chip for coding and video creation, and sweeping regulatory actions across the U.S., Europe, and China, and it's clear that the future of AI and tech is being redrawn this week.
