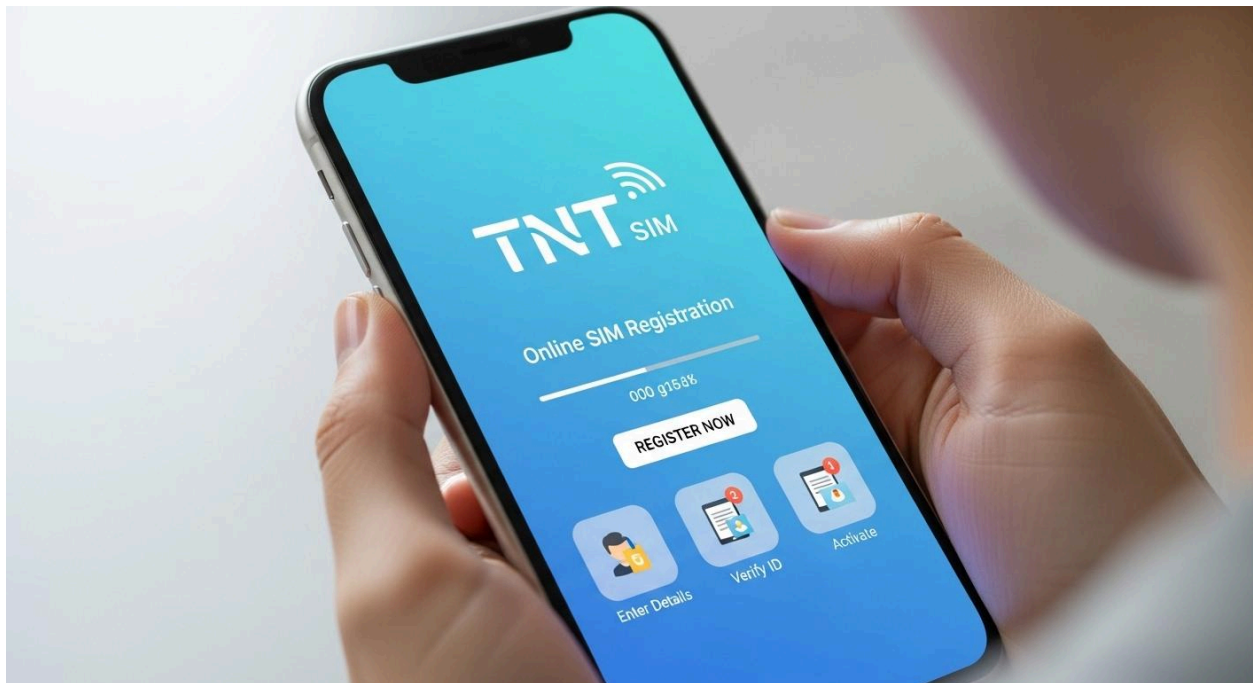


TNT SIM Registration Guide: How to Register Easily

TNT accepts multiple IDs such as:

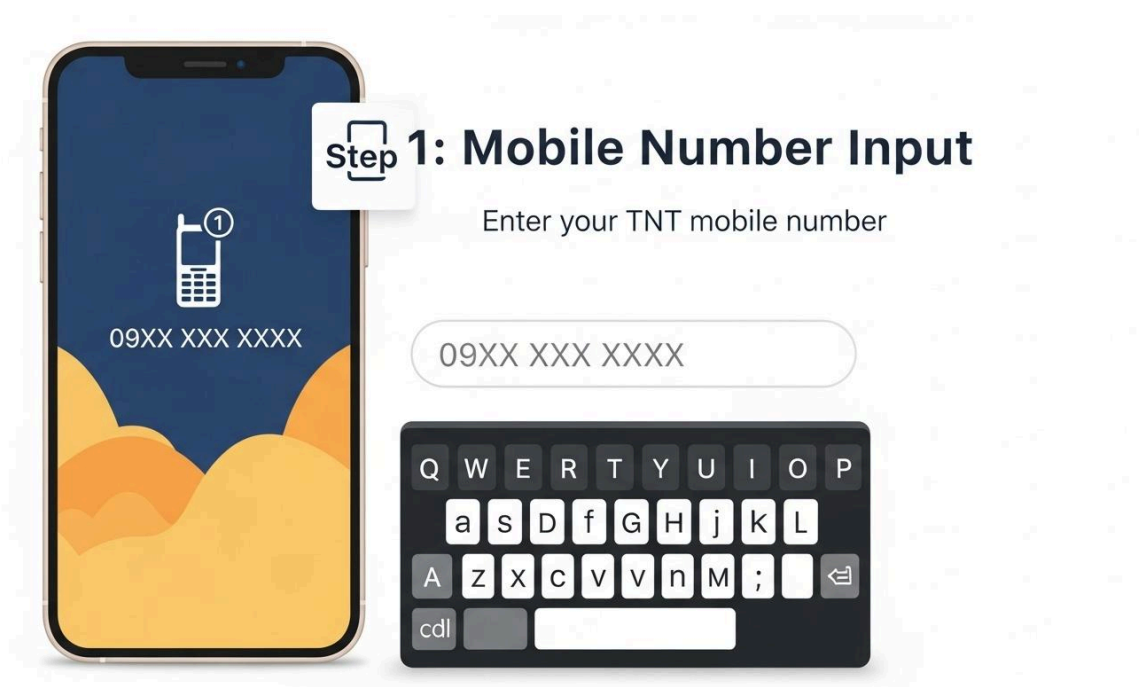
- Passport
