## Why Children Drop Out of School

Across India, economic hardship forces children to choose survival over schooling. In urban slums and informal settlements, families often struggle to afford even basic necessities.

### Major Reasons

#### 1. Financial Crisis

Parents cannot afford:

- School fees
- Books and stationery
- Uniforms
- Transportation

#### 2. Child Labour

Many children work in:

- Small workshops
- Roadside stalls

- Rag picking
- Domestic work

### **3. Lack of Awareness**
