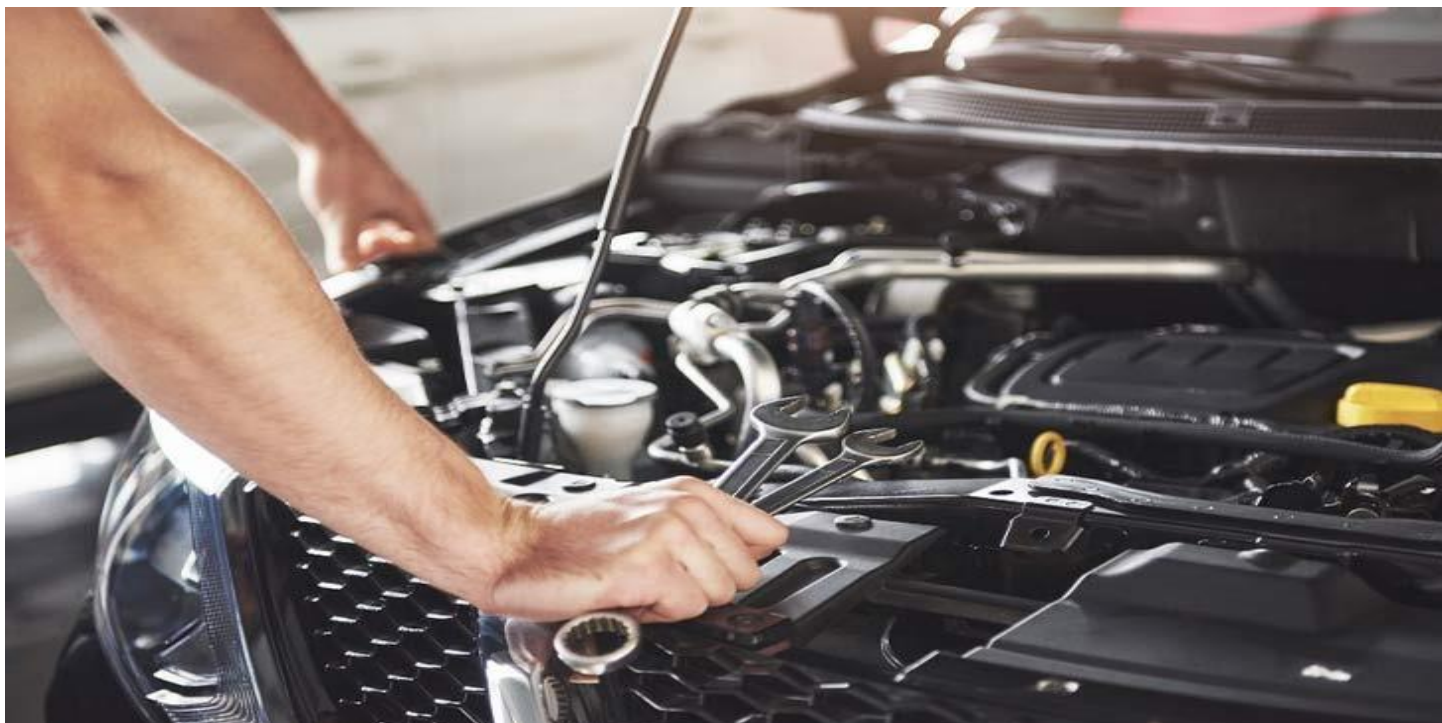




5 Common Winter Car Problems Every Auckland Driver Should Know
