What Is CAPEXIL?

CAPEXIL works to promote India's exports by providing exporters with trade-related information, business support, international market opportunities, and participation in promotional activities.

Businesses exporting eligible products may obtain CAPEXIL membership and the relevant RCMC (Registration-Cum-Membership Certificate) according to their product category.

What Is an Export Promotion Council?

An Export Promotion Council is an organization established to promote exports from a particular industry or product segment. EPCs help exporters connect with international markets and understand opportunities, policies, and industry requirements.

Different councils cover different product categories. Therefore, exporters should select the council that corresponds with their principal export products rather than choosing an EPC solely based on its popularity.

GJEPC

The Gem & Jewellery Export Promotion Council (GJEPC) focuses on the gem and jewellery sector. Businesses exporting diamonds, gemstones, gold jewellery, silver jewellery, and other eligible gem and jewellery products may consider [GJEPC membership](#).

EEPC India

EEPC India primarily supports engineering exporters. Businesses involved in engineering products, machinery, industrial equipment, automotive components, and other eligible engineering goods may find EEPC India relevant.

Spices Board

The [Spices Board](#) focuses on the promotion and development of Indian spices. Businesses involved in exporting eligible spices and related products may need to follow the registration and compliance requirements applicable to their products.

CAPEXIL vs Other EPCs: Key Differences
