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What Is APEDA Farm Registration?

APEDA Farm Registration is associated with the registration and compliance requirements for businesses involved in exporting agricultural and processed food products covered by the Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA).

APEDA works under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, and promotes the export of scheduled agricultural and processed food products. Farmers, agricultural businesses, exporters, processors, and other eligible businesses may need to understand APEDA requirements when entering international agricultural markets.

For exporters, obtaining [APEDA registration](#) and the applicable Registration-Cum-Membership Certificate (RCMC) can be an important step in establishing their export business.

Step-by-Step APEDA Farm Registration Process

Step 1: Obtain an Import Export Code

Businesses intending to export from India generally need a valid Import Export Code (IEC) issued by the [Directorate General of Foreign Trade \(DGFT\)](#).

The IEC identifies the exporter and is an important part of the export documentation process.

Step 2: Check Product Eligibility

Before applying, identify the agricultural or processed food product you intend to export.

The product should fall under APEDA's scheduled product categories if you are applying for APEDA-related registration or RCMC.

Step 3: Prepare Business and Farm-Related Documents

Applicants should collect the documents required for registration. Depending on the business structure and activity, these may include:

- IEC
- PAN
- GST registration details
- Business registration documents
- Bank account details
- Address proof
- Product details
- Authorized signatory information
- Farm or production-related information, where applicable
- Other documents prescribed by APEDA

Step 4: Create an Online Application

The applicant can use the applicable APEDA online registration process to provide business and export-related information.

After successful verification and completion of the applicable process, the eligible exporter can receive the relevant APEDA registration or RCMC documentation.

The exporter should maintain the certificate and keep business information updated.

APEDA Registration for Farmers and Agricultural Businesses

Farmers who only produce agricultural goods for domestic sale may not necessarily require APEDA exporter registration simply because they operate a farm.

However, when a farmer, Farmer Producer Organization (FPO), agricultural company, or other business undertakes export activities, it may need to meet applicable APEDA and export requirements.

For example, an agricultural business exporting fresh fruits, vegetables, cereals, processed foods, or other scheduled products should evaluate whether APEDA registration and RCMC are applicable.

APEDA Registration in Delhi

Businesses based in the National Capital Region may search for [APEDA registration in Delhi](#) when planning agricultural exports. Applicants can complete the applicable registration process through APEDA's prescribed online system rather than relying solely on physical submission.
